

## CARDINAL MOTOR SYMPTOMS<sup>1,2</sup>

- Symmetrical muscle weakness, usually proximal, especially of the hips and shoulders
- Muscle wasting and muscle cramps
- Functional impairment, including: inability to run, gait alteration, difficulty getting up from the ground and climbing stairs
- Difficulty raising arms above head
- ☐ Hand tremors
- Tongue fasciculations (muscle twitches)



#### BONE SYMPTOMS<sup>1</sup>

- Skeletal deformities (scoliosis and hip dislocation)
- Joint contractures



### RESPIRATORY SYMPTOMS<sup>1,3</sup>

Reduced breathing ability



#### GENERAL SYMPTOMS<sup>1,2</sup>

- Fatigue
- Episodic weakness
